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A Three Week Study for pre-teen/Tween girls

Week One

God's offer for the girlchild Redemption

Despite the fall of the first girl ever, God still desires the girl child to be a pillar for Him according to His initial plan in Gen1. What would the girl child do now? Is this the end of her being able to be a pillar? Would God extend to her another offer?

Though the devil deceived the first girl and lured her into accepting his offer, God brought a second offer to her again, He unveil His rescue plan. Unfortunately not many girls are accepting this offer. Many girls still long for the devil's offer for their lives.

Whose offer would you take? God's offer of making you into a graceful pillar or the devil's offer of giving you the forbidden fruit? (Can you give me examples of these forbidden fruits?)

Boy friending, pop music, bad friends, immodest dressing etc.)

Read John 3:3 and use the guideline below

- a. What must happen to every woman?
- b. Why must they be born again?
- c. Who is speaking here?
- d. John 3:14 -16
- e. What did Jesus compare been born again to?
- f. Did you see an animal mentioned?
- g. Where did we learn about the name of this animal before in the Bible?
- h. What did Jesus said will happen to him just as Moses did?
- i. What should be the response of people?
- j. If you believe what will happen to you?
- k. What else do you see from these verses

Read Numbers 21:4-9 and follow the guideline below

- a. What did you take from these verses?
- b. What did the people do against God and Moses?
- c. What do we call that, is that sin?
- d. What was sent into their midst?
- e. When they cried for help, what was Moses supposed to do?
- f. When the Serpent is made what should those bitten do?
- g. What happened to those who looked to Moses Serpent?
- h. Did you see that Jesus' death on the Cross is like Moses' serpent?

- i. How can a girl look to the death of Jesus?

Conclusion

Since the first girl disappointed God, it becomes very difficult for any girl to become a pillar, yet God is still looking for a graceful pillar; therefore, in order for Him to get her to be one, He gave Jesus.

If indeed you want to be God's graceful pillar, you must first allow Jesus into your heart, and transform your black dirty heart to the red heart, a heart that is cleansed by the blood of Jesus, and afterwards He will begin to carve you into a graceful pillar. The death of Jesus on the Cross of Calvary began the beginning of the girl child becoming a pillar once again in God's hands.

Week Two

The response of the girl child to what Jesus did on the cross

The heart that every girl child was born with was the heart of the first girl child (Eve) after she fell. That was the black, disobedient and corrupt heart, it is a heart that cannot please God, and therefore cannot be carved into a graceful pillar.

We saw last time that Christ in His death took that heart away and cleansed us by His blood, as we receive the heart cleansed by the blood of His Cross.

This week, we want to see what you must do as a girl child as your response to what Jesus did.

Even though Christ died to take away your black dirty heart, and cleansed your heart with His blood to give you the red blood cleansed heart in His death at Calvary. You as the girl child must personally accept His death for you, in order for your heart to become that white pure heart.

Week Three

NURTURING MY NEW HEART

Last time, we saw that as you confess Jesus as your Lord and believe that He died on the Cross to take away your black dirty heart, you now carry the pure white heart. This week, we want to look at the implication of Jesus's death on the cross for you who now has the pure white heart, as a result of your pure heart, Jesus must grow in you just as your plants must grow in order for you to get any fruit.

- c) Look at verses 3, 4 6, 11, 12 and mention what the tongue is compared to

- d) Looking at the things the tongue is compared to and share the danger of an untamed tongue.
- e) What else can you see from these verses?

iii. Read Prov 18:21 and follow the questions below

- a) What are the two things that the tongue has the power to do?
- b) Do you see that your tongue bears fruit?

iv. What we used to use our tongue for

Read Proverbs 20:19

- a) From the above verse, what do you think girls usually use their tongue for?
- b) What else do you see from this verse?
- c) How should you use your mouth from now knowing that you are a new creation?

Conclusion
